- 1953 Family immigrates to Canada, lives in Stratford, Ontario
- 1965 Moves to Minneapolis, Minnesota
- 1969 Returns to England to study
- 1970-71 Studies at the Camden Art Centre, London, England
- 1975 Foundation Studies & Fine Arts B.A. in Painting Camberwell School of Art and Design, London England
- 1976 Becomes Master of Props, Belgrade Theatre, Coventry
- 1977 Designs and builds special effects models for B.B.C. documentary, *Search for the Persian Royal Road*
- 1977-82 Exhibits and works as set painter in various theatres in England
- 1982 Returns to Canada and begins to paint full-time
- 1984 Receives *Art Forms Prize*, Kitchener-Waterloo Art Gallery
- 1985 Becomes Canadian Citizen, son, Liam is born
First major one-man show, Gallery Stratford
Becomes gallery artist at the Bau-Xi Gallery in Toronto and Vancouver
Starts making sculpture again
