ARTIST'S STATEMENT

I find the act of looking carefully to be complex, meaningful and satisfying; and I try to paint in such a way that the viewer can be similarly engaged. While my painting is sometimes compared to traditional Dutch or Flemish still-life, I am more concerned with the construction of the work than with pictorial illusion: with how brushstrokes can be simultaneously a suggestion of light or material and a mark on the painting's surface; how an image can be simultaneously a cup or vase and a collection of marks and colours.
